1. Project work

To draw the graph of a quadratic polynomial and observe:

- (i) The shape of the curve when the coefficient of x^2 is positive.
- (ii) The shape of the curve when the coefficient of x^2 is negative.
- (iii) The shape of the curve when the equation is not consistent.
- (iv) The shape of the curve when the equation has equal roots.
- (v) The shape of the curve when the equation has unequal roots.

Material required-

Graph paper, ruler, pencil, eraser, pen, adhesive.

How to do:- take different type of quadratic equation as i) if coefficient of x^2 is positive the we can take an equation as $2x^2 + 3x - 5 = y$. now put the different values of x and get the value of y and draw the graph.

2. Make a chart of the formulas for the chapters

Trigonometry, mensuration, statistics and arithmetic progression.

Where to do?

You can use any type of page for this. But if possible then use a chart paper. Do all the formula on the same chart paper.

SUBJECT: SCIENCE

PHYSICS:

1. Collect the damaged printed circuit boards (pcb) of different electronic devices/ electrical devices. See the components used on it. Are you not ever curious about that? What are they? What are the names of them? What type of function they do?

So for getting all these answers match the figures with the internet search and name it. If any number is given on it then type it on internet and see what name appears there. Draw the figures of it on paper and write the name and function of it. If possible then you can stick them on the page.

2. "Story of bulb."

Talk to your grandfather/ parents and ask to recall the time when they firstly see the electricity? What type of bulb they are using at that time? What are changes come in journey of bulbs? Try to collect every type of bulbs, make their figures on copy and write that on which technology they glow. for example if you have seen the cfls then make the figure and try to explain the working/ function

of that. Go through the internet.

BIOLOGY:

- 1. "All plants give out oxygen during day and carbon dioxide during night". Do you agree with this statement? Give reason.
- 2.. How do the guard cells regulate opening and closing of stomatal pores?
- 3. Two green plants are kept separately in oxygen free containers, one in the dark and the other in continuous light. Which one will live longer? Give reasons.
- 4. If a plant is releasing carbon dioxide and taking in oxygen during the day, does it mean that there is no photosynthesis occurring? Justify your answer.
- 5. Explain the mechanism of photosynthesis.
- 6. Explain the three pathways of breakdown in living organisms.
- 7. Describe the flow of blood through the heart of human beings.
- 8. Describe the process of urine formation in kidneys.

Chemistry:

- 1. Why should water be never added dropwise to concentrated Sulphuric acid?
- 2. Name the products formed in each case-(a) hydrochloric acid reacts with caustic soda.
- (b) Granulated Zinc reacts with caustic soda. (c) carbon dioxide is passed into lime water.
- 3. Why does hydrogen chloride gas not show acidic behavior?
- 4. What is meant by water of crystallization? Describe an activity to show that blue COPPER Sulphate crystals contain water of crystallization.

Note: All the work should be done in a file with A4 size paper.

SUBJECT: SOCIAL SCIENCE

- 1. Construct/ make a three dimensional Models/chart (any one), using thermocol, plaster of Paris, water colours, wooden tray, chart paper, velvet papers, husk, sand, etc. Showing
